## TUITION

There is a \$650 participation fee for Mean Girls/ Mean Girls Jr. which is due on the first day of rehearsal. **Payments must be in the form of a check made out to Black Rock Theater on the first rehearsal.**

## CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Actors are also required to be enrolled in at least one class at BRT. Actors in Mean Girls Jr. can take any class of their choice.

**\*NEW FOR FALL '26\*** Actors participating in Mean Girls (Full Version- Grades 9-12) are required to take MT Dance/ Ballet 4 and it is strongly recommended that they add on another acting/ musical theater class.

**Attendance Policy** Actors participating in Mean Girls and Mean Girls Jr. are allowed 2 excused absences from their BRT classes. Any absences beyond that will affect show participation and future casting.

## CAST CONTRACT

### Attendance:

- Mean Girls rehearsals and shows must take priority over other rehearsals/ after school activities. All rehearsal conflicts must be submitted along with auditions. Conflicts should be reserved for emergencies and urgent matters only. If I have a conflict, I am responsible for learning the material I missed. If I do not submit a conflict ahead of time and I miss rehearsal, it is not guaranteed that I will be in the scene/song rehearsed.
- There are no Tech Week conflicts and no exceptions to this rule. Since we add many elements (set pieces, lighting, etc.) during Tech, it can be a safety concern if actors are not present. Tech incorporates the work of many different designers and technicians and it makes their job difficult if the entire cast is not present.
- I understand that I am allowed *two* excused absences for my required BRT class/ classes. Any absences beyond that will affect show participation and future casting.

### Memorization:

- I understand that it is my responsibility to practice lines, music, staging and choreography at home. Each weekend, I will attend rehearsal prepared and off book (memorized) from the previous weekend's rehearsals. By Tech Week, I will have my show fully memorized.

### Professionalism:

- I recognize that this semi-professional show is a labor of love and combines the hard work of many designers, technicians, and creatives! I understand that all actors and roles are valued and appreciated in BRT's artistic community. Above all, it is my responsibility to show kindness and respect to fellow castmates and BRT professionals. **We have a zero tolerance policy for any unkind behavior.**
- The rehearsal room and theater are **strict no cell phone zones**. Cell phones may only be used with explicit permission from the directors. Taking photos or videos during rehearsals, backstage, or performances is strictly prohibited. Any social media posts featuring BRT students or professionals must have their consent beforehand. Violating this policy may result in the loss of backstage privileges or removal from the production.
